#### ELECTRIC PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE

- (a) whether Government has been taking any steps to curb pollution by promoting electric public transport infrastructure in Delhi-NCR areas; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the timeline of such projects and budgetary allocation for the same?

(a) (&) (b): Yes, Sir. The Government has taken steps for promoting electric public transport infrastructure through Phase-II of Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Hybrid and Electric Vehicles in (FAME-INDIA) scheme. The objective of the Scheme is to reduce dependency on fossil fuel and to address issues of vehicular emissions.

The Scheme is pan India basis including Delhi-NCR for a period of 3 years commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2019 with budgetary allocation of Rs. 10,000 crore. On purchase of Electric vehicles for public transport, upfront Incentive is offered under the scheme and also supports creation of necessary Charging Infrastructure for electric vehicles. Under this scheme about 500 electric buses amounting to Rs 250 Crore (Approx.) Govt. incentive are sanctioned to Delhi-NCR for public transport.
